Daniels Selected to Speak Aboard Celebrity Cruise Lines

Born in Brooklyn, New York, Daniels' paternal family hails from St. Kitts and her mother's family from the Orangeburg, SC. She will depart in April and has plans to make various stops on the islands to speak to business leaders and community organizations.

A former Savannah Morning News journalist turned entrepreneur, she often speaks before business organizations, youth groups and women's conferences and is the author of two books, the latest titled [It Takes Tenacity, 15 Power Moves to Survive the Wilderness and Weather the Economic Storm](#).

To nab the job, Daniels went through a rigorous interviewing process with the cruise line's booking partner agency Sixth Star Entertainment that involved previous work assignment screenings and referrals that included an endorsement from Dr. Ken Boyd, VP of Economic Development at Savannah Technical College. Boyd has worked with Daniels to deliver training for the college as well as some of its clients and said "her instructional techniques are excellent and her knowledge base is quite expansive. She is highly thought of by all clients and is very professional."

Daniels, who is also the founder of the [Tenacious Woman Conference](#), will depart in late April returning during the first week of May just in time to celebrate her birthday.
